
NSC Bloodborne & Airborne Pathogens Course Description

Is Your Organization in Compliance with the OSHA Standard?



Employees, business owners and anyone who has a reasonably anticipated occupational exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials in the course of their work is covered under the OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standard 29CFR 1910.1030.

This <u>NSC instructor-led classroom course</u> helps reduce these risks by focusing on how to protect employees from blood and airborne pathogens and what to do if an exposure occurs. The course covers:

- Fundamentals of bloodborne pathogens training
- Essential information on hepatitis viruses and HIV
- How to prevent infection from bloodborne pathogens
- Key facts about airborne pathogens, including tuberculosis

Course Content and Materials

In addition to the entire text of the OSHA standard and glossary of terms, this course includes:

- Action to take if an exposure occurs
- The Needle Stick Safety and Prevention Act
- Record-keeping and exposure control plans
